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MATERIALS & TOOLS

Yarn → cotton Schachenmayr Catania.
Hook → 2, 50 mm crochet hook or according to the yarn.
Others → Polyester fiberfill for stuffing, safety eyes (8mm), yarn needle, sewing needle, scissors, stitch marker.

ABBREVIATIONS

mr → magic ring
ch → chain stitch
sl.st → slip stitch
sc → single crochet stitch
hdc → half double crochet stitch
hdc-inc → crochet two half double crochet stitches in the same stitch
dc → double crochet stitch
tr → triple crochet stitch
... → *repeat directions following* as many times as indicated
[...] → work directions inside square brackets into stitch as indicated
inc → increase – crochet two single crochet stitches in the same stitch
dec → invisible decrease two stitches together using the invisible decrease method

NOTES

Work in continuous rounds (no joining required) do not join rounds or turn, unless instructed otherwise in the pattern.
Use a stitch marker or a piece of yarn to mark the end or the beginning of a round.
All stitches are worked into both loops, unless instructed otherwise in the pattern.
Stuff your doll as you go.

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LEGS- With yarn A  Stuff the legs as you go.

For the foot you have to start each round with a chain and close it with a slip stitch through the first stitch. Do not count them as stitches.

rnd		sts
1	6 sc in magic ring, join with a sl.st.	6 sc

From now on your 1st stitch is where you slip stitched into earlier.

2	Ch 1, *1 sc, 1 inc* 3 times, join with a sl.st.	9 sc
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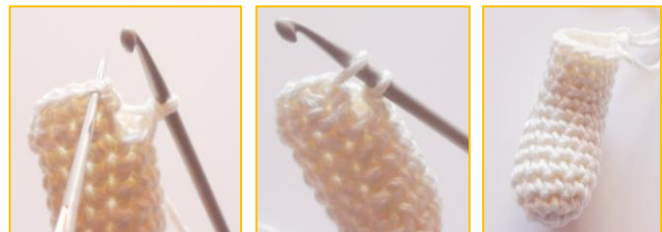
3	Ch 1, *2 sc, 1 inc* 3 times, join with a sl.st.	12 sc
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4-7	(4 rnds) Ch 1, 1 sc in each stitch around, join with a sl.st.	12 sc
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We are going to work in rows

8-10	(3 rows) Ch 1, 6 sc, turn your work	6 sc
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Stop turning your work and join the yarn with a sc to continue in rounds as the pictures show.




11	6 sc (in the remaining stitches of round 7) + 6 sc (in row 10)	12 sc
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12-28	(17 rnds) 1 sc in each stitch around	12 sc
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Fasten off with a sl.st. and weave in the remaining yarn tail.

Left leg - Repeat rounds 1-27. On round 28 crochet 9 sc instead of 12.

DO NOT cut the yarn at the end of the left leg.

BODY-With yarn A  Stuff the body as you go.

Ch 4 (left leg), skip **4 stitches** after the slip stitch you made earlier (right leg) and join to the right leg.

31	12 sc (around the 1 st leg), 4 sc (along the chain), 12 sc (around the 2 nd leg), 4 sc (along the bottom of the chain)	32 sc
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32	1 inc, 10 sc, 2 inc, 2 sc, 2 inc, 10 sc, 2 inc, 2 sc, 1 inc	40 sc
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33	*9 sc, 1 inc* 4 times	44 sc
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34-39	(6 rnds) 1 sc in each stitch around	44 sc
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40	*9 sc, 1 dec* 4 times	40 sc
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41	1 sc in each stitch around	40 sc
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42	8 sc, 1 dec, 18 sc, 1 dec, 10 sc	38 sc
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43	1 sc in each stitch around	38 sc
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44	8 sc, 1 dec, 16 sc, 1 dec, 10 sc	36 sc
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45	1 sc in each stitch around	36 sc
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46	*4 sc, 1 dec* 6 times	30 sc
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47-48	(2 rnds) 1 sc in each stitch around	30 sc
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49	*3 sc, 1 dec* 6 times	24 sc
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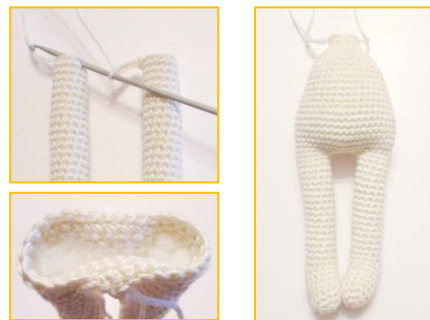
50	1 sc in each stitch around	24 sc
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51	*2 sc, 1 dec* 6 times	18 sc
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52	*1 sc, 1 dec* 6 times	12 sc
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53	1 sc in each stitch around	12 sc
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Crochet **8 sc** more. Place your stitch marker into the last stitch. This is the new beginning of your next rounds.



HEAD-With yarn A  Stuff the head as you go.

rnd		sts
1	*Inc* 12 times	24 sc
2	*3 sc, 1 inc* 6 times	30 sc
3	*4 sc, 1 inc* 6 times	36 sc
4	*5 sc, 1 inc* 6 times	42 sc
5	*6 sc, 1 inc* 6 times	48 sc
6-18	(13 rnds) 1 sc in each stitch around	48 sc

Insert the safety eyes between rounds **9-10** and leave a space of 10 stitches between them. Embroider the eyebrow with brown embroidery thread. Sew the nose in the middle of the eyes on round **8**.

19	*6 sc, 1 dec* 6 times	42 sc
20	*5 sc, 1 dec* 6 times	36 sc
21	*4 sc, 1 dec* 6 times	30 sc
22	*3 sc, 1 dec* 6 times	24 sc
23	*2 sc, 1 dec* 6 times	18 sc
24	*1 sc, 1 dec* 6 times	12 sc
25	*dec* 6 times	6 sc

Break the yarn and close the remaining hole. Weave in the yarn through the front loops of all 6 stitches and pull tightly. Make a knot and hide the remaining yarn tail.




ARMS -With yarn A  **DO NOT** stuff the arms.

rnd		sts
1	8 sc in magic ring	8 sc
2-22	(21 rnds) 1 sc in each stitch around	8 sc


Crochet the sides together with 4 sc. Fasten off and leave a yarn tail long enough to sew the arms to the body.



WIG-With yarn C 

rnd		sts
1	6 sc in magic ring	6 sc
2	*Inc* 12 times	12 sc
3	*1 sc, 1 inc* 6 times	18 sc
4	*2 sc, 1 inc* 6 times	24 sc
5	*3 sc, 1 inc* 6 times	30 sc
6	*4 sc, 1 inc* 6 times	36 sc
7	*5 sc, 1 inc* 6 times	42 sc
8	*6 sc, 1 inc* 6 times	48 sc
9-21	(13 rnds) 1 sc in each stitch around	48 sc
22	3 hdc, 3 dc, 3 tr, 2 dc, 2 hdc, 1 sc, 3 tr, 3 dc, 9 hdc, 18 sc, 1 sl.st.	48 sts

Put the wig in place and sew it onto the head following the contour border. Embroider 5 strands of hair for the bangs.


BRAIDS-With yarn C 

Make a magic ring, *ch 30, 1 sl.st. in the mr* 6 times. Repeat the same process for the second braid. Fasten off and leave a yarn tail long enough to sew the braids on round 12 of the wig leaving 12 stitches distance between them.







Fasten off with a sl.st. and weave in the yarn with a needle join method.

Attach yarn B  to each top corner (back side) and make 25 chains.



With yarn D  crochet ch 40 and fasten off. Make a bow and sew it onto the dress.


BOW- With yarn B  make two.

Chain 5 (leave a long tail at the beginning to finish the bow later) turn and crochet all the following stitches in the in 5th chain from the hook [3 tr, 1 sl.st, chain 4, 3 tr, 1 sl.st] in the same stitch.

Cut the yarn leaving a long yarn tail and fasten off. Draw the loop tightly closed. Wrap the yarn tail around the middle of the bow a few times and knot the yarn tails together on the wrong side.



Sew the bows to the braids.

DRESS- With yarn B 

Begin with ch 28.

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|----------|--|--------|
| 1 | Start in 3 rd chain from the hook,
1 hdc in each chain, turn | 26 hdc |
| 2 | Ch 2, 4 hdc, ch 5, skip 5 stitches,
1 hdc, 1 hdc-inc 4 times, ch 5,
skip 5 stitches, 4 hdc, turn | 30 hdc |
| 3 | Ch 2, *4 hdc, 1 hdc-inc* 6 times,
turn | 36 hdc |
| 4 | Ch 2, 1 hdc in each stitch around,
turn | 36 hdc |
| 5 | Ch 2, *8 hdc, 1 hdc-inc* 4 times,
turn | 40 hdc |
| 6 | Ch 2, *9 hdc, 1 hdc-inc* 4 times,
turn | 44 hdc |
| 7 | Ch 2, *10 hdc, 1 hdc-inc* 4 times,
<u>join with a sl.st.</u> | 48 hdc |

From now on, your 1st stitch is where you slip stitched into earlier. Start each round with ch 2 and close it with a slip stitch through the first stitch. Do not count them as stitches.

ASSEMBLY OF THE DOLL

- Sew the arms onto round 51.
- Sew the wig onto Zoe's head.
- Sew the braids onto the wig.
- Sew the bows onto the braids.
- Dress Zoe with her dress.
- Sew the bow onto the dress.
- Put a little bit of blush on the cheeks.
